Ed belonged to the American Radio Relay League and, during the Vietnam War, he spent many a weekend and holidays connecting servicemen in Vietnam with their families via an acoustical coupler that allowed them to talk freely at little or no charge. Ed continued to work into his 90's at what he loved best...selling radio parts at an electronic flea market held every weekend in the state of Maine. All his parts were culled from salvage that he purchased from the government or privately. He is survived by his son, Robert.
